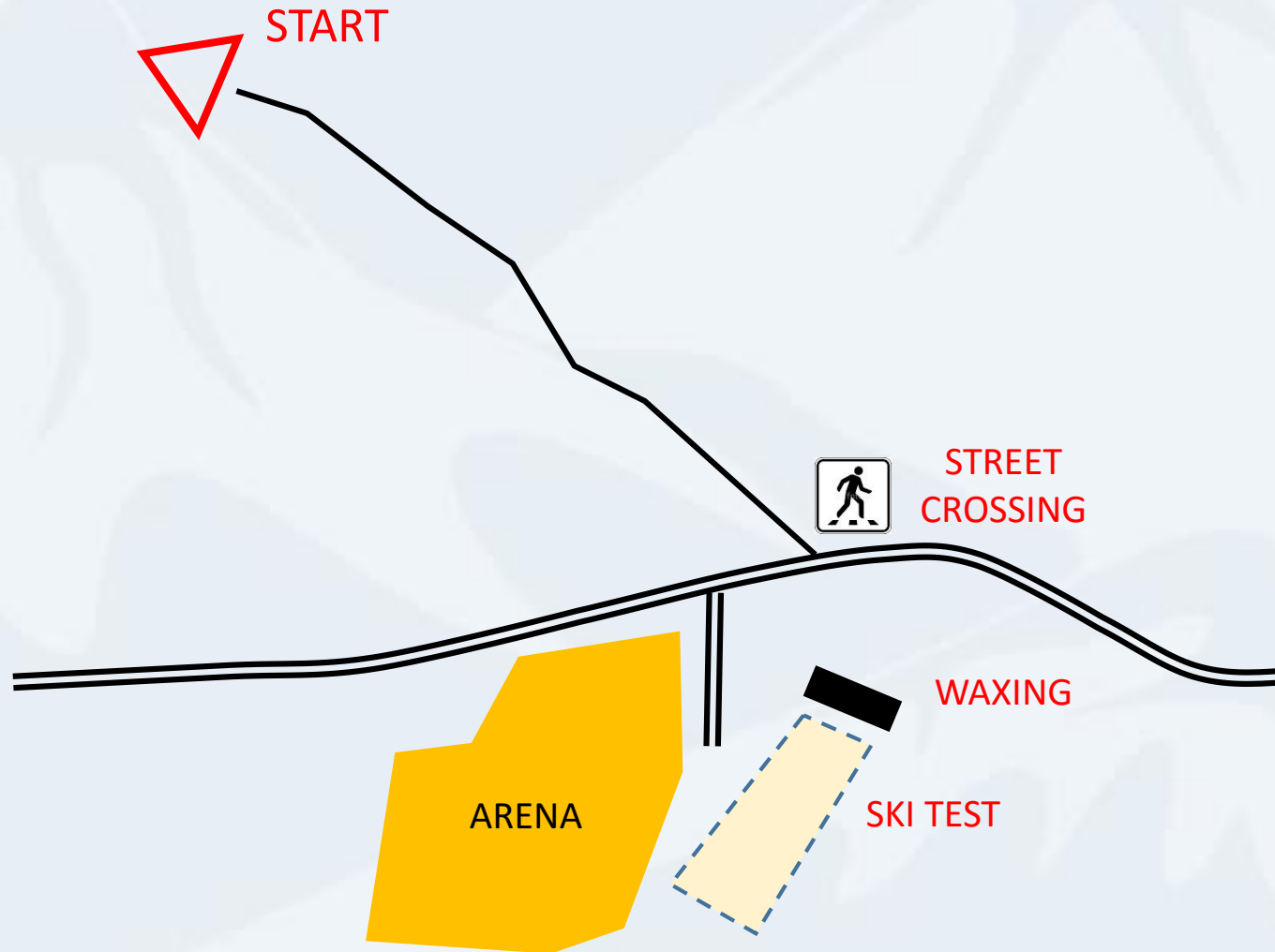

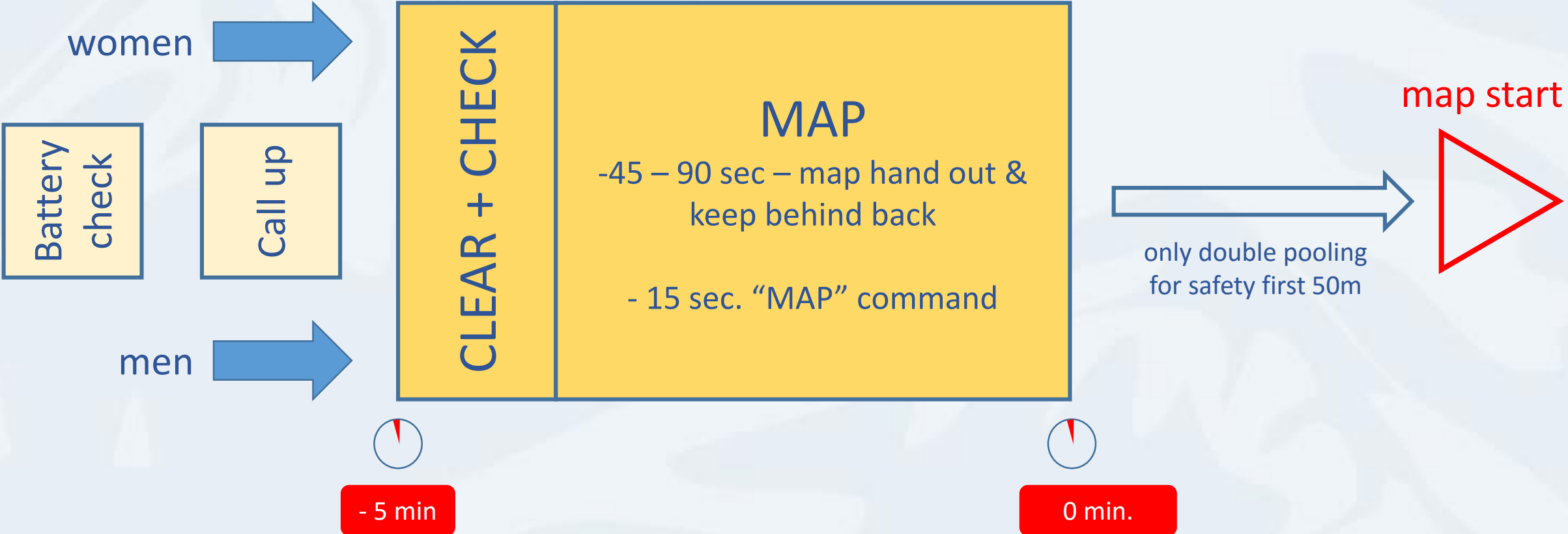


Mass Start - Mixed Sprint Relay

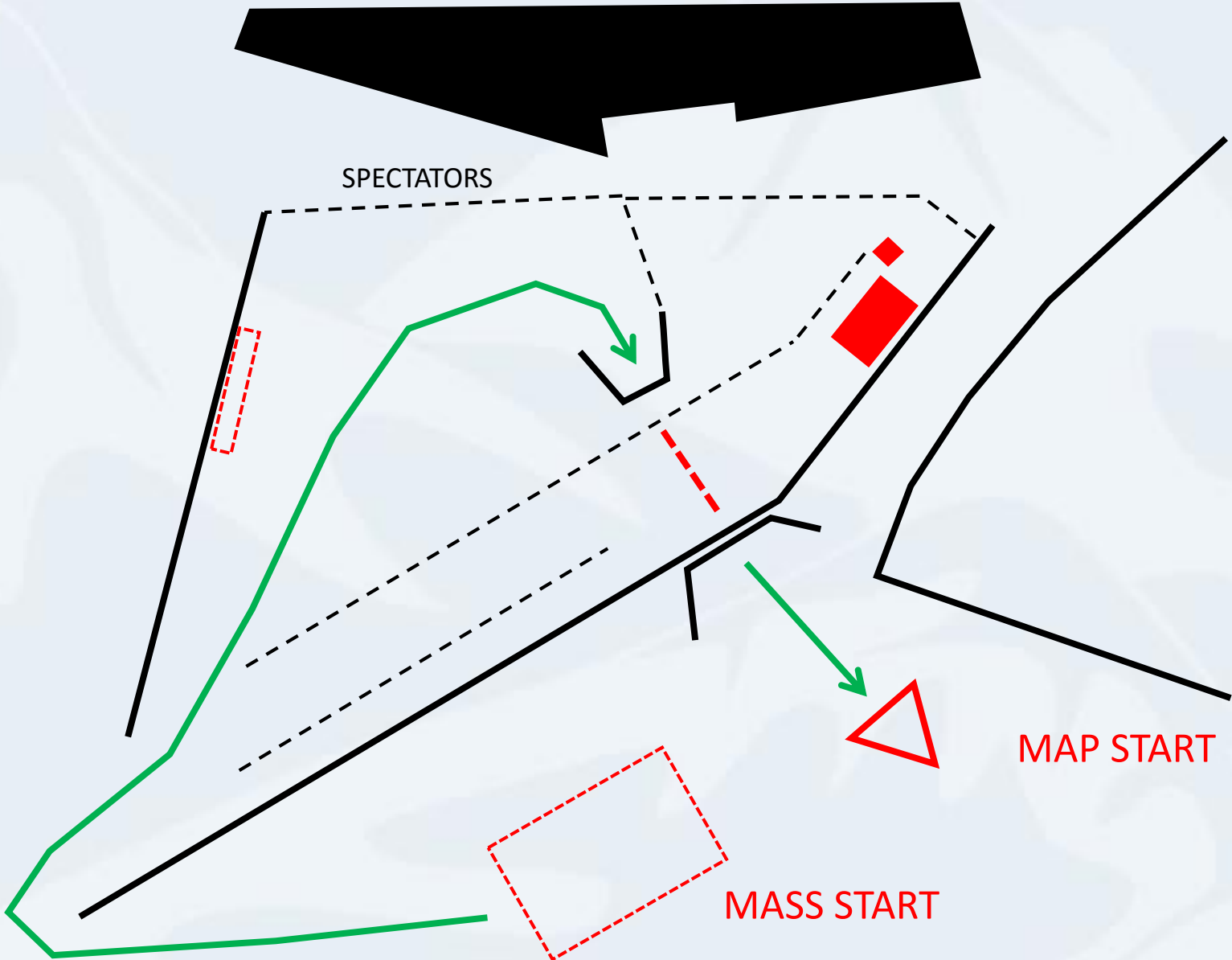

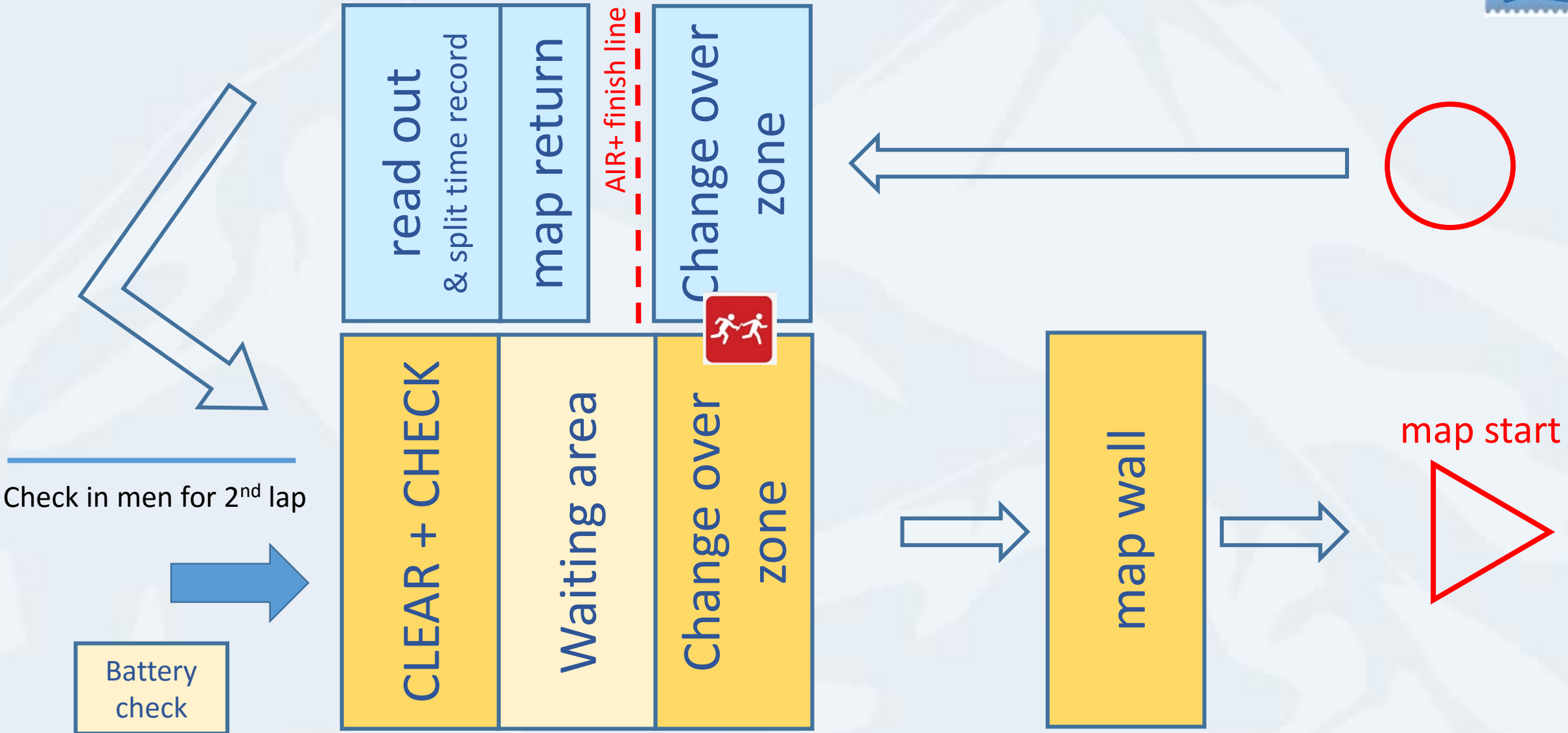
1st lap women



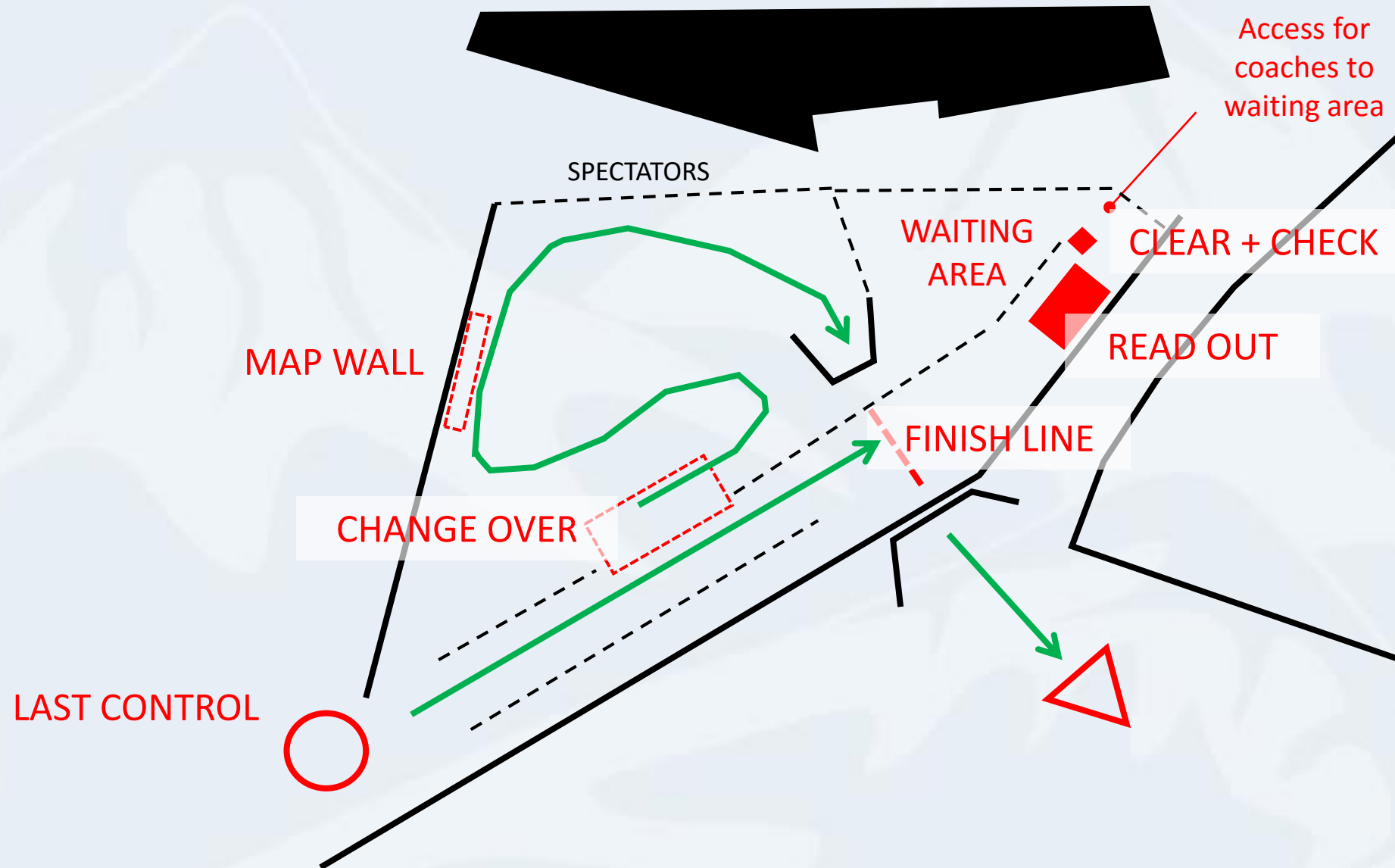
Mass Start - Mixed Sprint Relay

Finish + Change Over – Mixed Sprint Relay

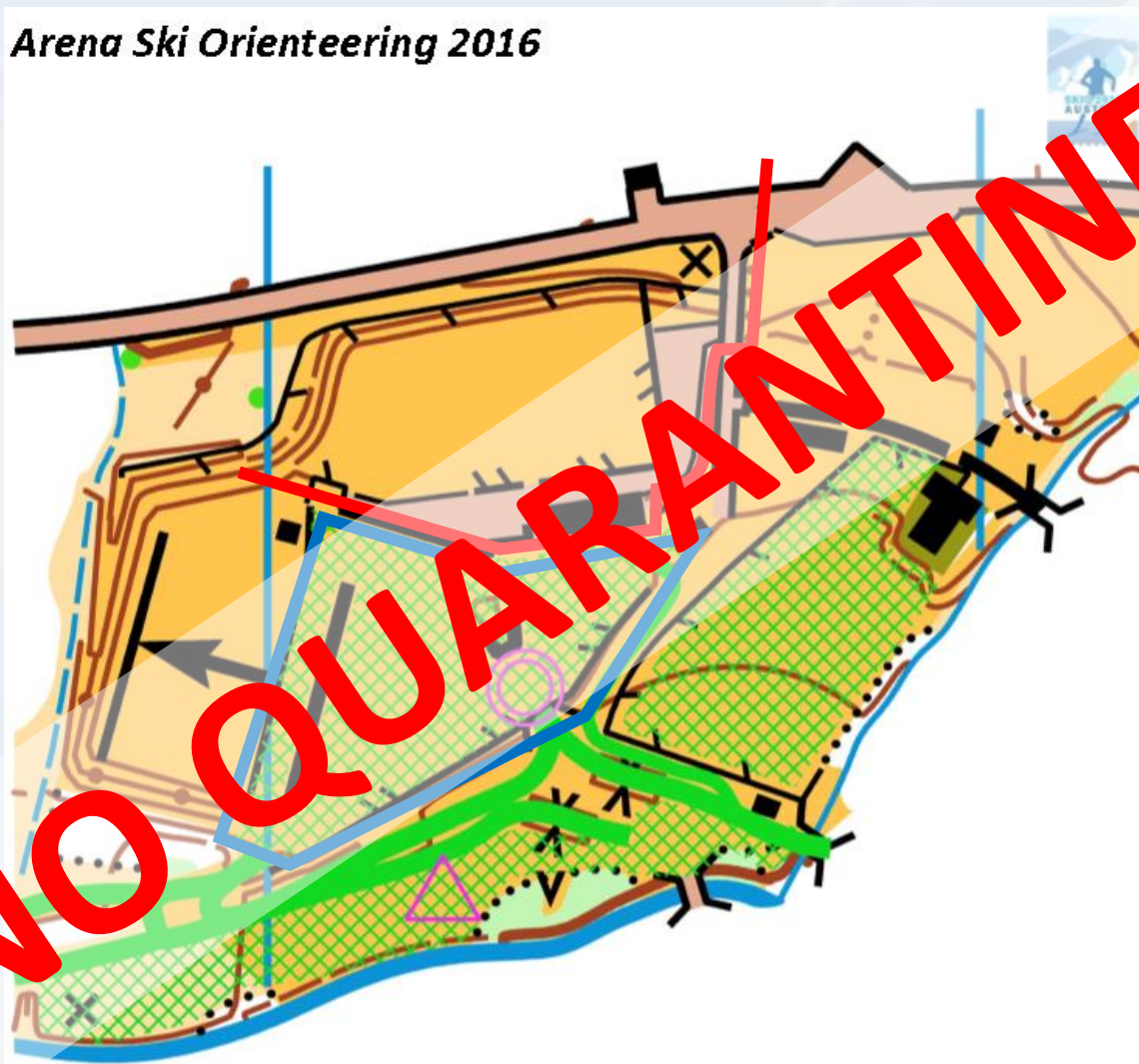

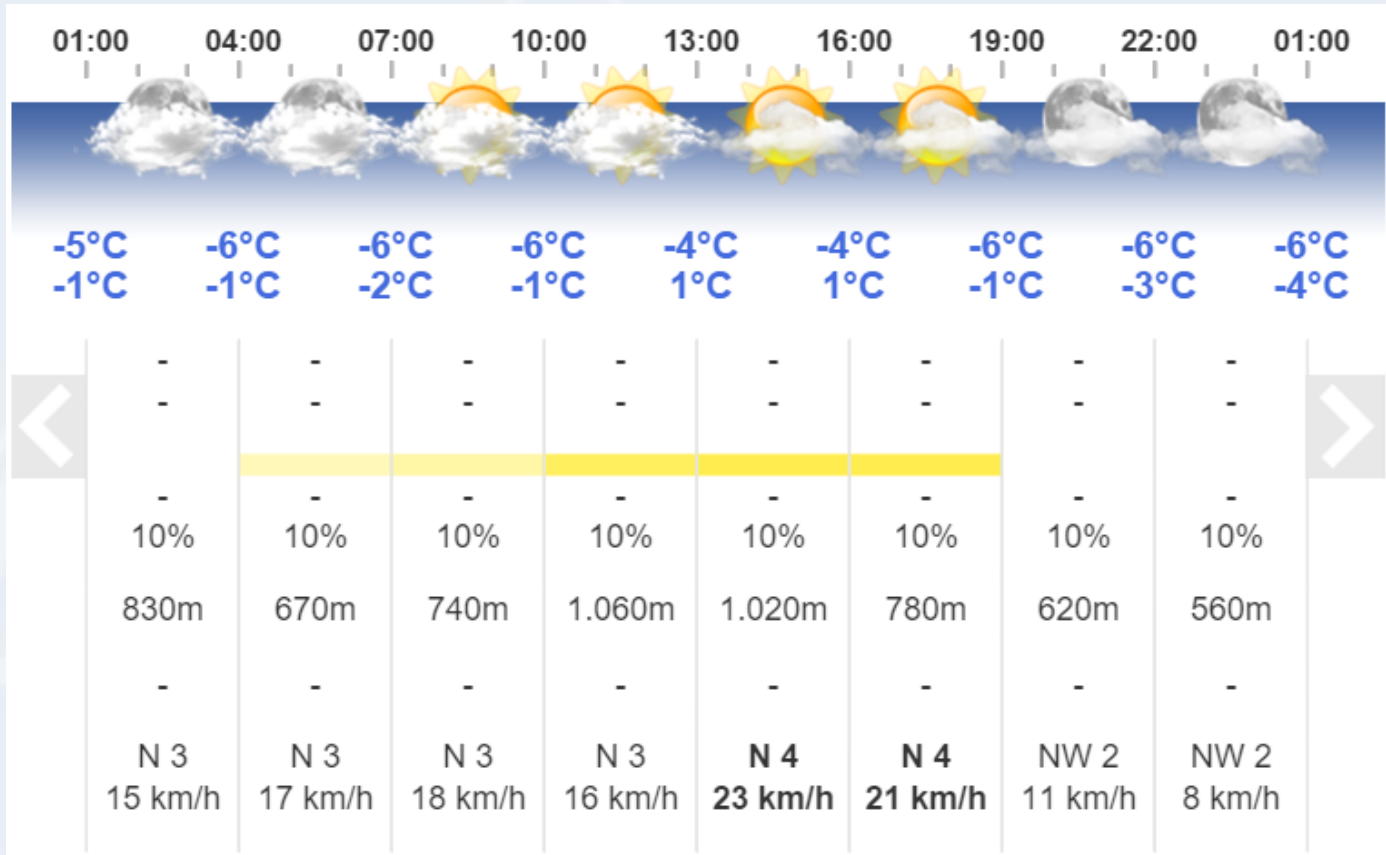


GPS Tracking devices according start list
