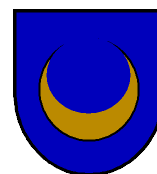

The Competition Center is located at the biathlon arena in Obertilliach. (GPS 46°42'33"N 12°35'27"E). The distance from Munich International Airport to Obertilliach is approximately 300km by car. The nearest railway station is in Lienz. (40 km by car)

5 Classes and Participation restrictions

ESOC: In the individual competitions Federations may enter a maximum of 6 competitors in each class. Federations may enter 2 teams in the Relay and 3 teams in the Sprint Relay.

World Cup: In the individual competitions Federations may enter a maximum of 6 competitors in each class. Federations may enter 2 teams in the Relay and 3 teams in the Sprint Relay.

JWSOC: In the individual competitions Federations may enter a maximum of 6 competitors in each class. Federations may enter 2 teams in the Relay.

EYSOC: In the individual competitions Federations may enter a maximum of 6 competitors in each class. Federations may enter 2 teams in the Relay.

6 Terrain Type / Opportunities for Training

Typical alpine valley with forest, marches and open fields. The terrain is situated between 1250m and 1400m.
